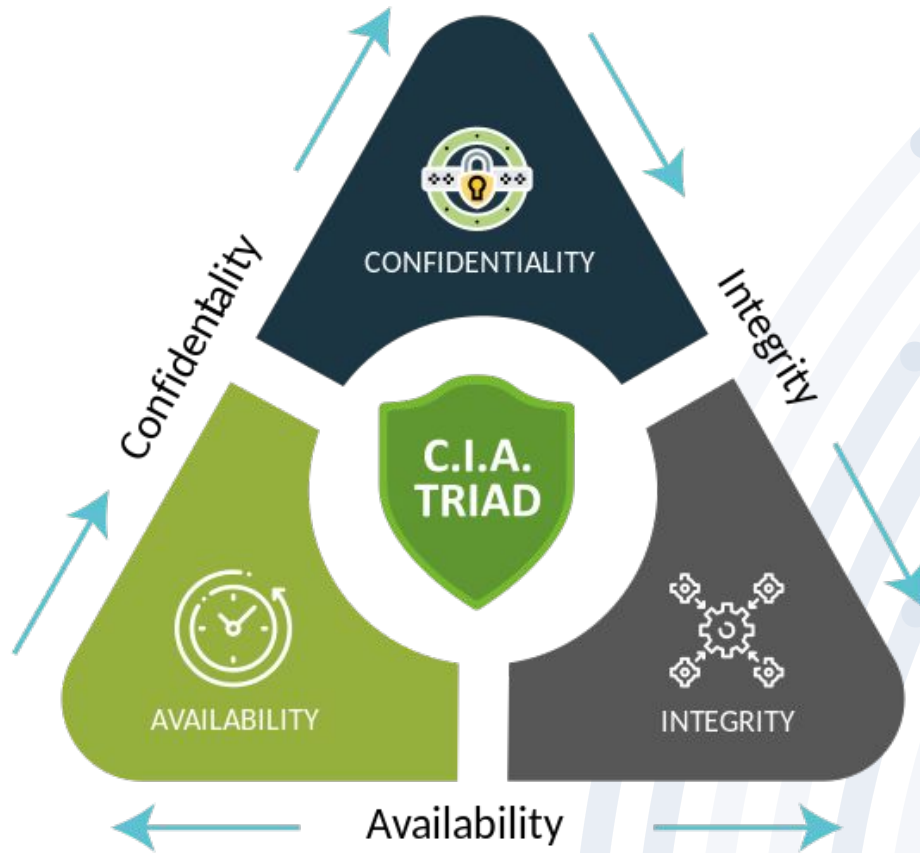

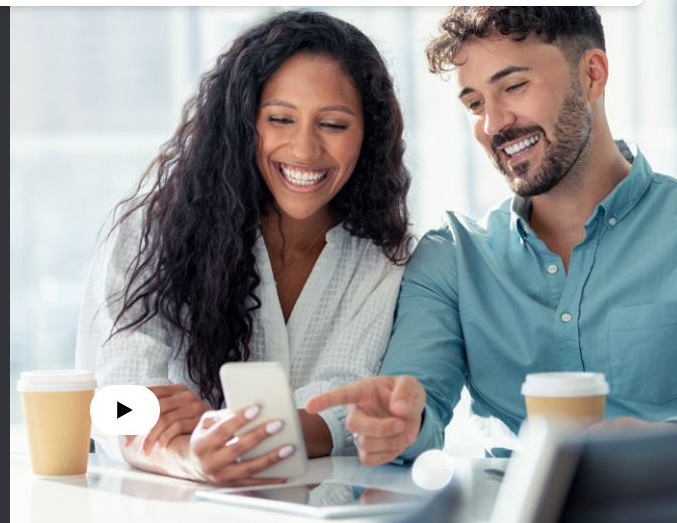

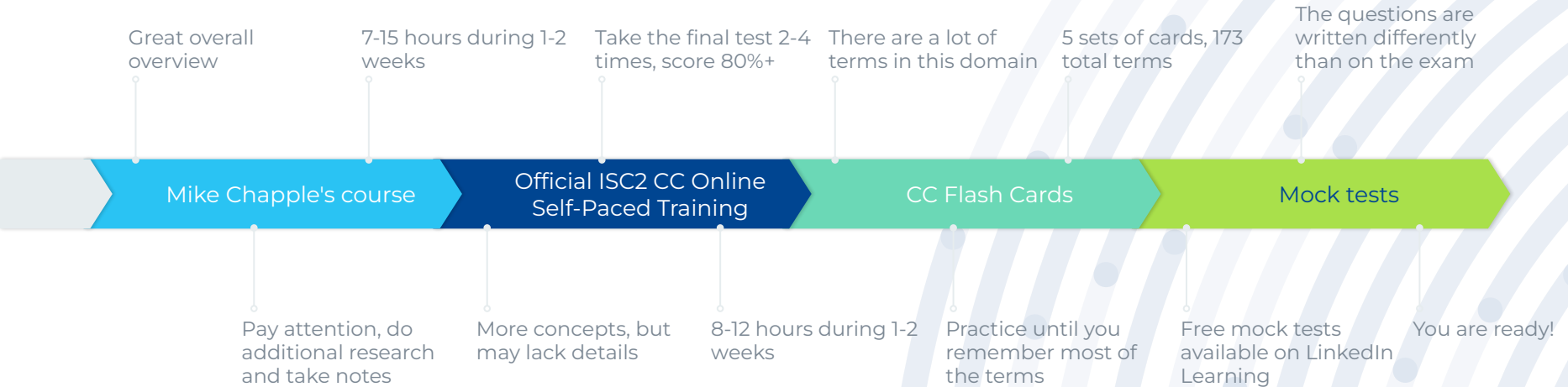

What to expect

What to expect at the test center

- Read and sign some forms.
- Photo before the exam.
- Palm or fingerprints scan before and after the exam.
- Snacks and water/coffee available.
- A locker is available.
- You will be escorted into the testing room.

What to expect at the test center

- Voice and/or video recording.
- A passive noise-cancelling headphones.
- A special erasable board and pencil.
- The monitors are usually 16:9.
- The exam simulator takes up the entire screen. A little inconvenient to read.

What's next?

I passed the exam. What's next?

Three steps:

1. Apply online for ISC2 membership.
2. Pay the Annual Membership Fee (AMF).
3. Earn Continuing Professional Education (CPE) credits.

2 and 3 are recurring activities.

ISC2 membership

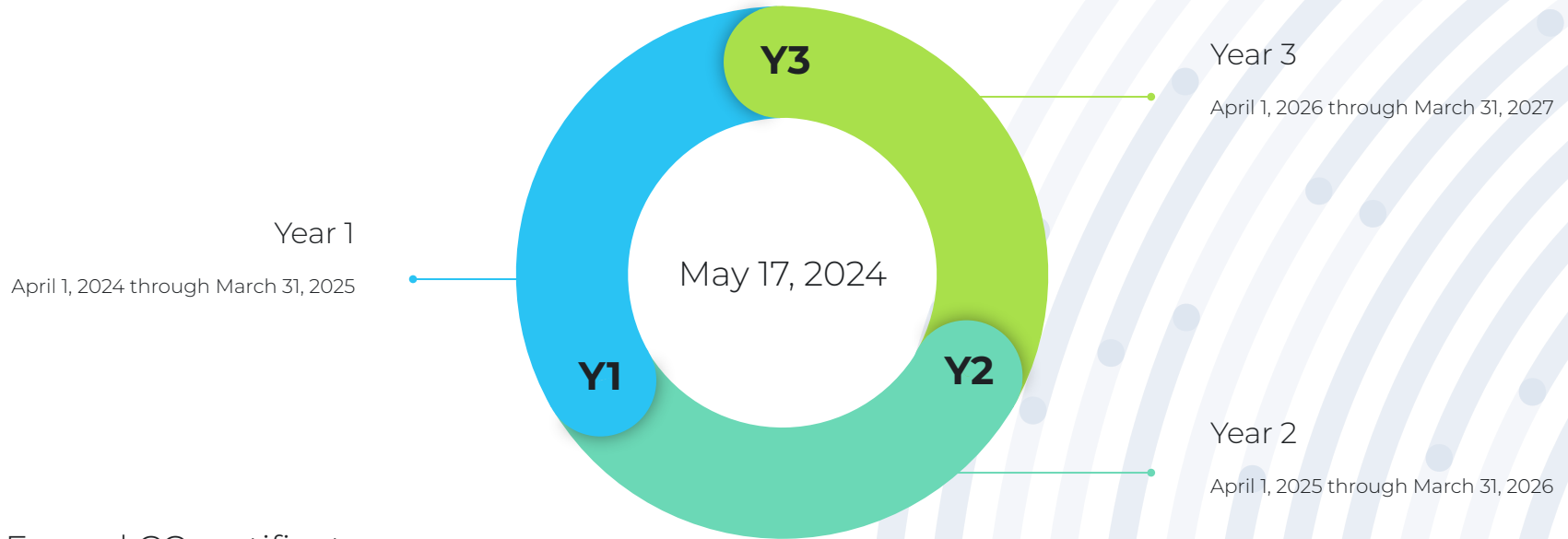
You must pay 50 USD to get a certificate (and become a member of ISC2).

Annual Membership Fee (AMF)

Payment of the AMF is required at the beginning of each year of your 3-year certification cycle to maintain an "active" status of your certification.

Note that the certification cycle does not run on a calendar year from Jan to Dec. It is based on when you were first certified.

Annual Membership Fee (AMF)



Earned CC certificate:
May 17, 2024

Continuing Professional Education (CPE) credits

- You must earn 45 CPE credits every 3 years.
- 1 hour of learning equals 1 CPE credit.
